



Cottonmill and Sopwell Hub 100 Club Rules

Overview

To fundraise for Cottonmill and Sopwell Hub (CASH) we will be running a quarterly lottery 100 Club.

The rules are as follows:

Rules

1. The object of the 100 Club is to raise money for CASH (to see the aims and objectives of CASH, please see our Constitution: <https://cottonmillandsopwellhub.org/policies/>)
2. The 100 Club will be promoted by CASH. The responsible person is Kate Swindells, 71 Leyland Avenue, St Albans, AL1 2BD.
3. There are 4 draws per year. These will be held on June 30th 2019, September 26th 2019, December 19th 2019 and March 26th 2020.
4. Entry is limited to people age 18 or over, supporting CASH.
5. Each entry buys one number to be used for all draws.
6. Each entry is £3 per draw, £12 for all 4 draws, equivalent to £1 per month.
7. There is a limit of ten entries per person.
8. Players must register and pay in advance of the annual deadline of midnight on 31st March 2019 for entry into all four draws. If we have not received enough entries, we reserve the right to register additional entries for the next quarterly draws (September onwards).
9. Each entry is allocated a unique number, chosen randomly using <https://www.random.org/> shortly after the registration deadline has passed and all payments have been received, to ensure all numbers are allocated. This is recorded on the entries log.
10. Numbers are non-transferable.
11. The entries log is published online, visible to all.
12. The draw is made by using <https://www.random.org/> to pick one number at random from the total number of entries. This will be done by a member of the CASH committee in the

presence of one Sopwell resident as a minimum. Typically this will be done on Facebook Live.

13. The prize pot is 50% of all monies collected for June, September and March's prize draws. The other 50% goes to CASH. In December's prize draw, the prize pot is 60%, with 40% going to CASH.
14. The First Prize will be 50% of the quarterly prize pot (i.e. a minimum of 25% of the monies collected).
15. The Second Prize will be 30% of the quarterly prize pot (i.e. a minimum of 15% of the monies collected).
16. Joint Third Prizes will be 10% each of the quarterly prize pot (i.e. a minimum of 5% of the monies collected).
17. There will be NO rollover.
18. All efforts will be made to contact the winners by email or phone and their winnings paid electronically from CASH's bank account within two weeks.
19. The winner(s) will be announced on CASH's website and Facebook page and will be recorded on the entries log available online.
20. If winners cannot be contacted the winnings will be placed into CASH's general funds after six months.
21. New members will be admitted when numbers become available. A waiting list will be kept and numbers will be offered to the first person on the list.
22. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
23. We are aware that there may be times when problems occur. If you would like to make a complaint, or give feedback to help us improve our processes, then please get in touch at CASHSTA18@gmail.com. We will make a record of your comments and resolve where possible, or if appropriate change our procedures going forward.
24. CASH shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.

Prize illustrations: The prize amount is directly related to the number of entrants. With 50 number entries: ● First Prize - £37.50 ● Second Prize - £22.50 ● Third Prizes - £7.50 each. With 100 number entries: ● First Prize - £75 ● Second Prize - £45 ● Third Prizes - £15 each. With 200 number entries: ● First Prize - £150 ● Second Prize - £90 ● Third Prizes - £30 each.
